# Statistics 2019

- 4,209 calls for service
- 5% increase from 2018
- Alarm calls  $\approx$  8% of all calls
- Most crimes “opportunistic” in nature
- 8 Burglaries
  - 4 residential
  - 4 commercial
- Grand theft and petty theft decreased
- 12% of calls self-initiated by Patrol

# Traffic Collisions in 2019

- Injury collisions increased (43 in 2019 vs. 27 in 2018)
- Non-injury collisions decreased (57 in 2019 vs. 79 in 2018)
- Observations
  - Factors in Collisions
    - #1: Excessive speed (29)
    - #2: Right of way violations (19)
    - #3: Driving under the influence (18)

# Patrol Summary

- Average response time: 6:04 minutes
- Decrease in residential burglaries
- 12% of calls logged were field observations generated by Patrol
- Calls for service decreased by 239 calls
- 1,291 assistance calls for Sheriff, CHP and Fire Department
- Drove 116,000+ miles and conducted 31,000+ security/vacation checks
