Your next Rancho Santa Fe Homeowners Association election is right around the corner.

Even if you think you're registered to vote you may not be. Registration is not automatic.

Less than 50% of those eligible to vote are actually registered.

Last election, I thought I was registered and didn't find out that I wasn't until it was too late.

To vote on whether to acquire Garden Club building with \$2.4 million (plus a \$400,000 reserve) of the Association's \$6 million enhancement fund, whereby the Garden Club will donate the proceeds to charity, you have to fill out a registration form by 5:00pm **March 24th**.

To vote in the May election, you have to fill out a registration form by **April 25th, 2014**.

Even if you are registered, now is a good time to update your information by visiting: www.RSFRegister.com.

This year, there are several important issues we will be voting on that affect your everyday life, the value of your home, and the standards our community will live by.

IMPORTANT NOTICE FROM THE RANCHO SANTA FE ASSOCIATION:

A member of the Rancho Santa Fe Association desires to communicate with you. The Association has arranged for the delivery of this member's letter as an accommodation, and as required by law. In doing so, the Association has not shared your name, property address or mailing address with this member.

With respect to the Garden Club, the reserve fund contribution in the letter is incorrect. The correct amount is \$310,000. In addition, proceeds from the sale will be distributed to local non-profit groups through a committee comprised of board members from the RSF Association, the Garden Club and the RSF Foundation. The member's voter registration website is also not affiliated with the Association, and the Association has not independently verified whether the registration forms on the member's website are accurate. Association membership information cannot be updated through any third party website. The Association takes no position on the other information in the letter.

You only need to register once to vote on Association matters. If you desire to register, you may pick up a registration form at the Association's offices or the Association will mail a form to you on request.
